## WIRELESS JOEY RECEIVER SETUP GUIDE

Featuring Racecar™ Technology



#### STEP 1: Connect the Cables to Your Wireless Joey







Connect one end of either the HDMI cable or the RCA cables that came with the Wireless Joey to the corresponding port(s) on the receiver. Then, connect the other end of your chosen cable(s) to the corresponding port on your television.



Connect the power cord that came with the Wireless Joey to the "Power" port on the receiver.

#### STEP 2: Connect the Cables to Your Racecar™ Access Point





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Connect the Ethernet cable that came with the Racecar<sup>™</sup>Access Point to the "Ethernet" port on your Hopper. Then, connect the other end to the "Ethernet" port on the Racecar<sup>™</sup> Access Point. В

Connect the power cord that came with the Racecar<sup>™</sup> Access Point to the "Power" port. Plug the other end of the power cord into a power outlet.

#### STEP 3: Power Your Equipment







Plug the power cord from the Wireless Joey into a power outlet, and ensure that your TV is still plugged in. В

Turn on your TV and you will see a loading screen. This screen could last for several minutes. Once loaded, the Install Wizard will begin automatically.



If you do not see this screen, press the "Source/Input" button located on your TV until this screen appears.

## STEP 4: Pair Your Remote Control to Your Wireless Joey





Press the SAT button on the remote control that came with your Wireless Joey to pair it to your receiver. The remote will beep three times when the pairing is complete.





Once paired, the Install Wizard will proceed to the next step automatically.

QUICK TIP (

To avoid pairing the remote with multiple receivers, ensure that no other DISH receivers in your home are on the "Pair Remote Control" step or on the "Diagnostics" screen.

## STEP 5: Set Up Text to Speech (Optional)





A If you would like to have a digital voice read the onscreen text, use the arrows on your remote control to highlight "Continue with Text to Speech." Then, press SELECT.





If you do not want a digital voice to read the onscreen text. use the arrows on your remote control to highlight "Next," and press SELECT



If you don't select either option. the Install Wizard will automatically advance after 30 seconds.

## STEP 6: Set Your TV Resolution

#### Depending on the type of television you own, you may not see this screen. If this screen does not appear, skip to Step 7.





If the image on the screen looks clear and correct, use the arrows on your remote control to highlight the "Keep" option. Then, press SELECT.





If the image on the screen looks incorrect, use the arrows on your remote to highlight "Revert." Then, press SELECT.



If you don't select either option, the Install Wizard will automatically advance after 15 seconds.

## STEP 7: Connect to the Racecar™ Access Point





Your Wireless Joey will start scanning for the Racecar<sup>™</sup> communications system. You will have two minutes to press the WPS button on the Racecar<sup>™</sup> Access Point.





When your Wireless Joey detects the signal from your Racecar<sup>™</sup> Access Point, the Install Wizard will advance to the next step.

If your Wireless Joey fails to connect to the Racecar™ Access Point, check that the cable connections on your Wireless Joey and the Racecar™ Access Point are secure. Then, use your remote to highlight the "Try Again" option, and press SELECT.

## STEP 8: Link Your Wireless Joey to Your Hopper

#### Depending on the number Hoppers you own, you may not see these screens. If these screens do not appear, skip to Step 9.





Using the arrows on your remote control, highlight the Hopper you wish to link to, and then press SELECT.





Once connected, a "Linked" icon will appear next to the Hopper that you chose.

#### STEP 9: Activate Your Wireless Joey





If your Hopper is connected to the Internet, use your remote control to highlight the "Zip Code" field, and press SELECT. Then, use the number pad on your remote to enter your Zip Code. If your Hopper is not connected to the Internet, skip to step 9E.





Use the arrows on your remote control to highlight either the "DISH Account Number" or "Previous Receiver ID" field. Then, press SELECT and use the number pad to enter the selected number.

## <u>STEP 9: Activate Your Wireless Joey (Cont.)</u>





C Use the arrows on your remote control to highlight the "Activate" button, and then press SELECT.





Once activated, you will see a screen confirming that you activated your Wireless Joey successfully. The Install Wizard will then advance to the next screen automatically.

## STEP 9: Activate Your Wireless Joey (Cont.)





**E** If your Hopper is not connected to the Internet, call 1-800-333-DISH (3474) to activate your Joey. Have your Receiver ID and Smart Card ID ready for the DISH representative.





Once activated, vou will see a screen confirming that you activated your Wireless Joey successfully. The Install Wizard will then advance to the next screen automatically.

**QUICK TIP** 

After one minute of inactivity, your receiver will advance to the next step automatically. If this occurs, call 1-800-333-DISH (3474) to activate vour receiver.
